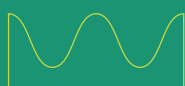
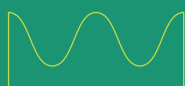




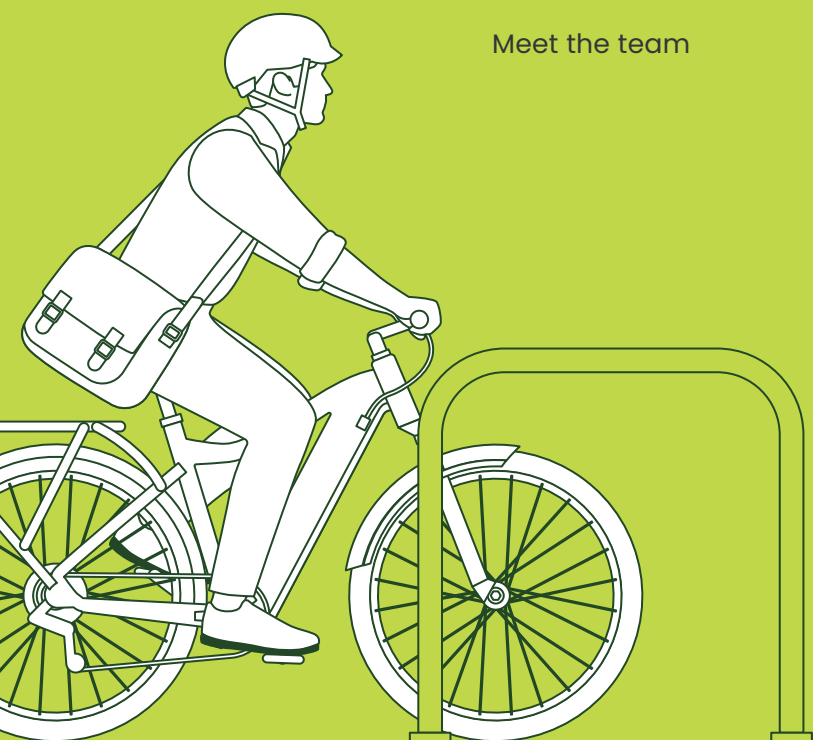

Working alongside landscape architects and local authorities, we design and build furniture that respond to the rhythms of daily life. From seating and wall-tops to planters, picnic tables, litter bins, and bollards, each piece is made in the UK from recycled steel and FSC Iroko Timber, alongside our new sustainable options: thermally modified Endura timber and reclaimed tropical hardwood. This approach maintains exceptional quality whilst reducing environmental impact and minimising lead times.

The details, like backrests curved to support you through that long phone call, drainage systems that keep planters flourishing through unpredictable British weather, and finishes that weather gracefully over years of use are the ones that help tell our story. It's our commitment to comfort by design and community by intention.

From pocket parks to high street regeneration, we collaborate closely with you through every stage, from initial sketches to final installation. We work with you to create spaces where communities naturally gather, rest, and thrive. Because the best street furniture disappears into the background of life, supporting all the moments that matter.

Design

The magic happens in the details: a backrest angled precisely to support natural posture, drainage channels discreetly woven into planters, powder coating formulated to weather gracefully through seasons of British rain and sun.

Modular thinking means endless possibilities: benches that extend into planters, cycle parking that can shift locations with use patterns, or seating configurations that encourage both solitary reflection and spontaneous conversation. Each project becomes a thoughtful response to how people actually move through and use their shared spaces.

And when you're looking to design the perfect bespoke outdoor space, we've got the perfect tool: an interactive configurator where you can explore combinations that feel right for your community's unique rhythm. Every space has its own story to tell, and every story deserves furniture that listens.

Sustainability and partnerships.



Sustainability

We believe durability is sustainability in action. Eight decades of making outdoor furniture have taught us something essential: the way we make things matters as much as what we make. Our Kent-based factory runs entirely on renewable energy, with wind power providing the foundation for each day's work.

Recycled steel forms the backbone of our furniture, saving 74% of the energy required for new material, not depleting natural resources (Iron Ore) to make virgin steel, whilst maintaining exceptional strength. FSC Iroko comes from carefully managed forests, whilst reclaimed wood from demolished British structures — sourced through our partnership with Ashwells' Timber Yard — finds new purpose in urban spaces.

Our Endura™ Thermally Modified Ash represents two years of research into enhancing locally grown timber, transforming British ash into material as resilient as tropical hardwood without long-distance transportation costs.

Creating furniture that lasts generations requires partners who share our exacting standards. Our relationships with Contracts Engineering and Custom Wytelyne exemplify how collaborative manufacturing elevates both product and process.

With Custom Wytelyne, we developed the Triple Process powder coating protocol independently tested to 2,000 hours in German laboratories. This three-stage system creates uniform coverage that resists weather elements, UV rays, and fading more effectively than traditional galvanising, whilst reducing environmental impact.

Contracts Engineering brings precision that allows our modular designs to achieve their full potential. Together, we engineered the UNIUN range's sixteen individual brackets down to two universal components, making manufacturing more elegant and maintenance more practical.

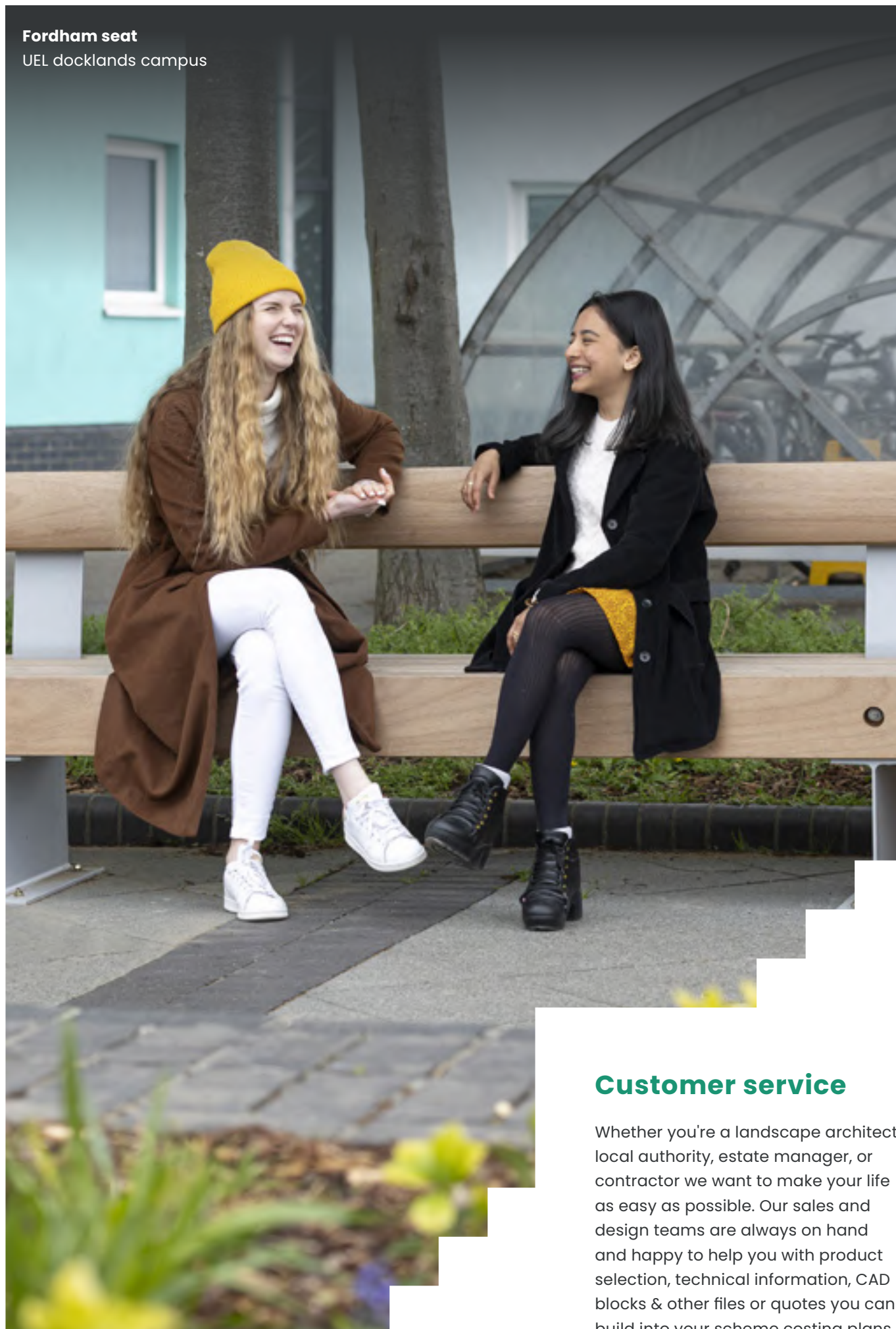

Recycled steel

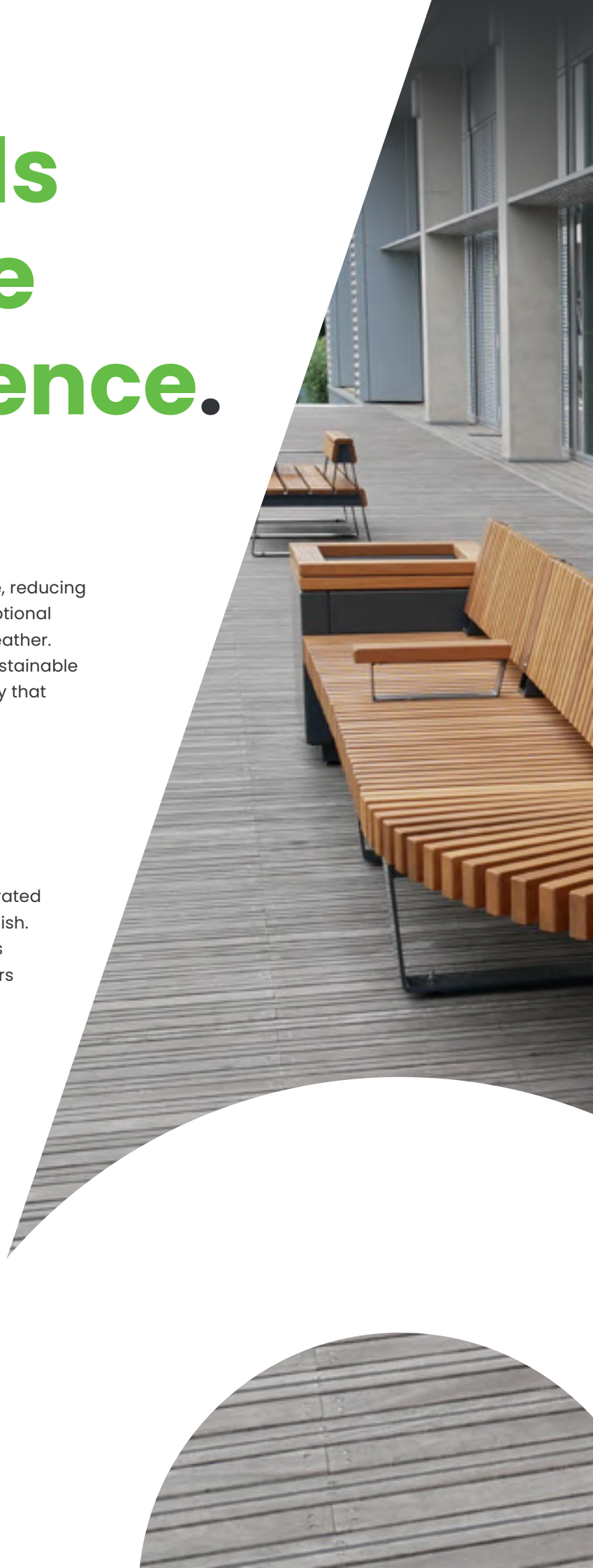
Recycled steel forms the foundation of our furniture, reducing environmental impact whilst maintaining the exceptional strength needed to withstand decades of British weather. This material choice reflects our commitment to sustainable manufacturing without compromising the durability that defines quality street furniture.

Triple-process coating

Our independently tested coating system delivers superior protection through three carefully orchestrated stages: shot blasting, protective primer, and PPC finish. This meticulous process eliminates adhesion issues and ensures smooth, lasting coverage that weathers gracefully through seasons of use.

Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) timber as standard

Iroko hardwood brings natural warmth to urban spaces whilst lasting more than 25 years in outdoor conditions. This exceptionally durable timber offers stability and cost-effectiveness over time. Our standard smooth planed finish develops a distinguished silver-grey patina within twelve months, though we offer various treatments to maintain the original colouration when preferred.
